

Council Chambers.
Forester's Falls, Town Hall, June 23rd 1917.

A meeting of Ross Council was held here on Saturday 23rd inst, all the members present, Reeve Kirk presiding.

A number of communications bills and accounts were then read and considered.

Mr. Jamieson gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law to give the Town Line and Seventh Line Telephone Association permission to extend their line from the corner of Mr. J. Richardson's lot along town line to Mr. W^m Fletcher's, thence along line between concessions 8 & 9 Township of Ross, to Duncan McLennan's lot.

Mr. Jamieson then introduced By-Law No. 350, of which he had given notice, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Rathwell, it was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. McEwen seconded by Mr. Preton, By-Law No. 350 was then read a second and third time short and finally passed.

By-Law No. 351 authorizing the reeve and treasurer to effect a loan on the Bank of Ottawa for the sum of Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars, to defray expenses of Good Roads Scheme, was read a first time, a second and third time short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr McEwen, seconded by Mr. Rathwell By-Law No. 341, as amended by By-Law No. 348, relating to the Good Roads Scheme, was read a third time short and finally passed.

Mr. McEwen gave notice that he would at the next meeting of Council introduce a bylaw to close that portion of road known as Gould's line, running through lots 8, 9 & 10, concession one, township of Ross.

Moved by Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr. Ireton, that Mr. McEwen have necessary notices posted re. closing of said Gould's line. Carried

Moved by Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Rathwell, that Mr Ireton be appointed to examine highway between lots 16 & 17 and report at next meeting of Council Carried

Moved by Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr Ireton that Mr McEwen have Tuffys Hill graveled. Carried

Moved by Mr. McEwen, seconded by Mr. Ireton, that the clerk write the Hydro-Electric Power Commission re-development of water-power on the Ottawa River to provide light and power in the Township of Ross. Carried.
