

Council Chambers  
Forester's Falls, Town Hall, Oct. 27th 1917.

Ross Council met here in the Town Hall to-day. All the members were present, the Reeve in the chair.

An error was found in the description of road No. 12 in By-Law No. 355 and it was corrected by striking out the words "16 to 20" and substituting therefor the words "11 to 15".

Then the minutes of previous meeting as corrected and read were adopted.

A number of communications bills and accounts were read and considered.

The commissioner's report respecting the opening up of the road allowance between concessions 3 and 4 and opposite lots 11 to 13 inclusive, for public use, was presented. The council after considering said report decided that the opening up of said road allowance was not necessary.

Mr James Lavallee got permission to state some facts re - killing of sheep. He said he did not know what dog had killed his sheep. He had tried to find out. It might have been his own dog.

Moved by Mr McEwen seconded by Mr Jamieson that Mr James Johnston have Government road opposite lot 5, Con. 8, gravelled.
