

Foresters Falls, May 25<sup>th</sup> 1918

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met here this day as a Court of Revision, the Court having been duly constituted, J. M. Jamieson was elected Chairman.

The following appeals against Assessment were presented  
 Mrs Stephen Bryce, Assessed too high  
 Mrs. Robert Bhlmer, Assessed too high  
 After due consideration of each appeal the Court reduced Mrs Bryce's Assessment \$2.00 and Mrs Buhlmer's \$5.00. Several alterations due to change of ownership having been made it was moved by Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr. Millar that the Assessment Roll as revised be approved and accepted. Carried.

The Court then adjourned sine die.

At one o'clock P.M. the Council met for the transaction of general business, the Reeve in the chair. The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and approved. Several communications bills and accounts were read and considered.

On Motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Barr J. Mc Donald was appointed pathmaster instead of Mrs. Horne and Archie Collins instead of John Gibson

It was moved by Mr. Millar and seconded by Mr. Jamieson that By-Law No. 355 as approved by the Minister of Public Works be now read a third time short and finally passed. Carried.

 Council met here this day at 10 o'clock A.M.  
 The Reeve in the Chair  
 The minutes of Court of Revision and last meeting of Council were read and approved and a number of bills and accts were presented and considered.

Mr. Barr gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law to authorize the Reeve and Treasurer to effect a loan of \$2000 from the Bank of Ottawa Potten to defray the expenses of the Good Roads scheme.  
 On motion of Mr. Miller seconded by Mr. Rathwell a grant of \$45<sup>00</sup> was made towards repairing and graveling road between Lots 10 and 11 Con 12
