Foresters Falls June 15th 1918
 Council met here this day at 10 o'clock A.M.
 The Reeve in the Chair
 The minutes of Court of Revision and last meeting of Council were read and approved and a number of bills and accts were presented and considered.

Mr. Barr gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-Law to authorize the Reeve and Treasurer to effect a loan of \$2000 from the Bank of Ottawa Potten to defray the expenses of the Good Roads scheme.
 On motion of Mr. Miller seconded by Mr. Rathwell a grant of \$45⁰⁰ was made towards repairing and graveling road between Lots 10 and 11 Con 12

On motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr. Miller the Reeve and Treasurer were authorized to effect a loan of Two Thousand Dollars from the Bank of Ottawa to be used to defray the expenses of the Good Roads Scheme

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Miller a grant of \$12⁵⁰ was made towards repairing Town Line between Ross and Horton opposite Con 6. provided that Horton spend an equal amt. for the same purpose.

Mr. Barr then introduced by-law No 361 of which he had given notice to authorize the Reeve and Treasurer to borrow from the Bank of Ottawa \$2000 to defray the expenses of the Good Roads scheme and on his motion seconded by Mr. Jamieson the By-Law was read a first-time.

On motion of Mr. Barr seconded by Mr. Rathwell the clerk was instructed to order from the Pedlar People Oshawa two corrugated iron Culverts as follows:

- (1) Diameter 15 in Length 16 ft
- (2) " " 10 in " " 16 ft

After adjournment for dinner, on motion of Mr. Rathwell seconded by Mr. Miller By-Law No 361 was read a 2nd and 3rd time short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr. Barr seconded by Mr. Rathwell the Treasurer was authorized to issue cheques in favor of the Road Commissioners for the amounts allotted to the several Roads under the Good Road scheme
