

Foresters Falls July 27th 1918

The Council met here this day, all the members being present. The Minutes of last meeting of Council were read and approved. A number of bills and accounts were read and considered. Mr Barrow gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law for the appointment of Sheep Valuator for the Township.

The Clerk was instructed to request the Council of the Township of Westmeath to build a bridge or culvert on the Town Line between Ross and Westmeath opposite Alex. Hawthorne homestead Ross to bear half the cost of same.

Mr Barrow then introduced by-law No 362 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Miller said by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Rastwell the blanks in by-law No 362 were filled in as follows:- John Mc Ginn, Edward J. Bulmer and Francis Crozier, and the by-law was then read a second and third time short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr. Rastwell seconded by Mr. Miller the following bills and accounts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment thereof.
