

Foresters Falls Dec. 14th 1918

The final regular meeting of Council for the present year was held here this day at 10 o'clock. A. M.

The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and approved and a considerable number of bills and accounts presented and taken into consideration.

Mr. Barr gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to provide for the holding of the municipal election for the ensuing year.
