

Foresters Falls May 31st 1919
 The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met here this day as a Court of Revision.

The Court having been duly constituted, J. M. Jamieson was elected Chairman thereof. The only appeal presented was that of Geo. Laporte who claimed that he was assessed for 120 acres of land more than he owned and also that he was assessed to. As it was clear that the acreage assessed was a clerical error on the part of the assessor it was reduced 120 ac. and the assessment on the land was reduced \$100⁰⁰/₁₀₀.

Village Lot 3 Bulmerville was assessed to John W. Pettigrew instead of to Mrs Robt Bulmer. Arthur Collins was assessed for a dog instead of Osborne Collins. On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr. Barr the clerk was instructed to make all necessary corrections in the Roll after which the Assessment Roll was approved and accepted as correct. The Court then adjourned. After recess the council met for the transaction of general business.

The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and adopted. A number of bills and accounts were presented including one from Dr. Brown M. O. H claiming a balance of \$215⁷⁵/₁₀₀ for vaccinating school children \$11³⁵/₁₀₀ paid Renshaw Mercury for printing placards and certificates and \$30⁰⁰/₁₀₀ for expenses attending Provincial Board of Health Association at Toronto. The Council agreed to pay the two latter items but declined paying the former on the ground that they had already paid the M. O. H all that was due him for his services in that regard.

On motion of Mr Miller seconded by Mr. Jamieson John H. Reynolds was appointed Sheep Warden in place of E. J. Bulmer retired.

On motion of Mr Barr seconded by Mr Rathwell the clerk was instructed to write the Council of Cobden re flooding of Road at Logan's Lake.

On motion of Mr Barr seconded by Mr Rathwell the overseers for the different roads named and described in by-law No 363 were appointed.

and the by-law was then read a third time short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr. Millar a grant of \$25⁰⁰ was made to gravel ^{hill} opposite Lot 18 & 19, Con 3.

On motion of Mr. Millar seconded by Mr. Rathwell. J. Do McLaren was given permission to perform 3 days & Labor in S. Muddock's Road Division

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Millar Mr Rathwell and Mr. Barr were appointed to examine Road leading to Hugh Pettigrew's.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr Barr, Mr Rathwell was appointed to examine drains at Haly Station with regard to the complaint of several parties there re flooding of their cellars.

On motion of Mr. Millar seconded by Mr. Jamieson J. C. McLaren was given permission to put a tile drain on Road Allowance opposite his lot.
