

Foresters Falls Aug 9th 1919

Council met here this day all the members being present. The minutes of last meeting of Council were read & approved.

M. H. Winter Agricultural Representative applied for a grant of \$20 towards the Children's Fair for the Township.

A more detailed statement of the M. H. Officer's account against the Township re small-pox patients was read & considered - also a notice from the County Judge served on the clerk appointing Monday the 15th day of September 1919 for the hearing of the application of the M. H. Officer to the said Judge for an order to settle the points in dispute between said M. H. O and the Council.

On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr Barr permission was given to Mr. Kallies to build a cattle pass under road through Lot 21 Con 4 provided he do a substantial job and sign an agreement as to the maintenance of the road over said pass in the future.

On motion of Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr. Barr the sum of \$20 was granted towards defraying expenses of Children's Fair Ross for present year.

On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr. Jamieson the sum of \$35 was granted to be expended under the supervision of Mr. Millar in improving Proof Line between Lots 5 and 6 along

On motion of Mr Rathwell, seconded by Mr. Millar the clerk was instructed to obtain particulars from the several parties of the bills for medical attendance re which the M. H. Officer is asking the Council to pay.

On motion of Mr. Millar seconded by Mr. Barr the following bill and accounts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treas for their payment.
