

Foresters Falls Sept 13<sup>th</sup> 1919

A Regular Meeting of Council met here this day, all the members being present. The minutes of last meeting of Council having been read and approved, bills and communications were received and considered.

Mr Millar gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to provide for the improvement of certain main and leading roads designated therein in the year 1920 under the terms and conditions of the Colonization Roads Act

Mr Rathwell gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to authorize and provide for the levying of all necessary rates for the present year.

Mr Millar then introduced by-law No 370 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr Rathwell the by-law was read a first time

Mr Rathwell then introduced by-law No 371 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr Millar the by-law was read a first time

On motion of Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Barr the blanks in by-law No 370 were filled in as follows:-

The several rates necessary to pay the School Debentures for U.S.S. No 3, S.S. No 6, and U.S.S. No 10 and the requisitions of the 13 Township School Boards several of which have not yet come to hand, and the by-law was then read a second and third time short and finally passed.
