

Foresters Falls Oct 25th 1919

Council met here this day all the members present except Mr. Millan

The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and approved and several bills and accounts read and considered.

Mr. Rathwell gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to provide for the appointment of a Tax Collector for the present year.

Mr. Rathwell then introduced by-law No 372 of which he had given notice to provide for the appointment of a Tax Collector for the present year and on his motion seconded by Mr Barr the by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr Barr the following bills and accounts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment thereof:-

On motion of Mr Barr seconded by Mr. Rathwell the blanks in by-law No 372 were filled in as follows: W. H. Murdock and \$ 65 and the by-law was then read a second and third time short and finally passed.

The Council then adjourned to meet again on the 15th day of December next at 10 o'clock A.M.
