

Foresters Falls Feb 25 1920

A meeting of Council was held here this day, all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair:-

Mr. Alex Bennett appeared before Council requesting that he be transferred from S.S. No. 9 to S.S. No 8. The Council having no power to alter the boundaries of School sections in this summary manner advised him to try to make some temporary arrangement with the Trustees of the respective sections, that would be mutually satisfactory.

At the solicitation of the Women's Institute a grant of \$50.00 was made towards the Armenian Relief Fund.

Mr. Millar gave notice that he would at this meeting of council introduce a by-law to authorize and provide for raising the sum of \$5000 by the issue and sale of debentures bearing 5 1/2 per cent interest for the purpose of building a Township Hall in the Village of Foresters Falls.

Mr Millar then introduced by-law No 376 of which he had given notice and on his motion, seconded by Mr. Jamieson the said by-law was read a first time.

Mr. Barr gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to provide for the appointment of Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks for taking the vote on the proposed debenture by-law.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Millar by-law No 376 was then read a second time.

Mr. Barr then introduced by-law No 377 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Jamieson the said by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr. Rathwell, seconded by Mr Barr, the blanks in by-law No 377 were filled in as follows:-

and the by-law was then read a second and third time short and finally passed

On motion of Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Barr the clerk was instructed to prepare the proposed debenture by-law, to have it published the requisite number of times in the Renfrew Mercury and to give due notice of the holding of the poll on said by-law

On motion of Mr Barr seconded by Mr. Rathwell the Clerk was instructed to lay before Dr McEullough the details of the difficulty between the Council and Dr J. Brown Medical Officer of Health with the request that the Provincial Board of Health approve of his dismissal.
