

Foresters Falls June 5th 1920

Council met here at 9 o'clock A.M. as a Court of Revision according to announcement. Mr. Jamieson was chosen as Chairman. Appeals were presented from Thomas Dean, C. J. Crozier and the Bateman-Wilkinson Co. on the ground that their assessment was too high.

On motion of Mr Barr seconded by Mr Rathwell the assessment of Thomas Dean was reduced \$100 and no action was taken on the other appeals. The Court then carefully examined the Assessment Roll, making the necessary changes due to change of ownership since date of assessment. The Assessment Roll as revised was accepted and the Court adjourned. The Council then met for the transaction of general business with the Reeve in the chair. The minutes of last meeting of Council were read and approved and several communications presented and considered. On motion of Mr Barr seconded by Mr Rathwell the resignation of Dr J. Brown as M.O.H. was accepted.

Mr. Rathwell gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law for the appointment of a Medical Health Officer for the Township. A deputation from the Cobden Agricultural Society waited on the council praying for a grant towards the Society.

On motion of Mr Barr, seconded by Mr. Millar a grant of \$125 was made towards this object.

Mr Rathwell then introduced ^{by-law} No 376 of which he had given notice for the appointment of a M.O.H. and on his motion seconded by Mr Jamieson the by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Barr a grant of \$40 was made towards repairing proof line between lots 15 & 16 Con 3.

On motion of Mr Millar seconded by Mr Barr the blank in By-law No 376 was filled in with the name of Dr J. Stewart and the by-law was then read a second and third time short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr Jamieson the following bills and accounts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment thereof:-

Foresters Falls June 11th 1920

On the call of the Reeve a meeting of Council was held here this day all the members being present.

A notice from the Department of Forests & Mines had just been received stating that a grant of \$1350 under By-Law 370 had been approved of.

The following were appointed assessors of the respective roads designated in the by-law:-

On motion of Mr. Barr seconded by Mr. Miller the amounts allotted to the different roads under by-law 370 were reduced proportionately so that the total amount expended under the by-law shall be \$2700.

Mr. Rathwell gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to authorize the Reeve and Treasurer to borrow the sum of \$2700 at 6 percent interest to defray the expenditure under By-Law 370.
