Foresters Falls June 11th 1920

On the call of the Reeve a meeting of Council was held here this day all the members being present.

A notice from the Department of Forests & Mines had just been received stating that a grant of \$1350 under By-Law 370 had been approved of.

The following were appointed assessors of the respective roads designated in the by-law:-

Road No 1 Alex Bennett.	Road No 2 James Headrick

On motion of Mr. Barr seconded by Mr. Miller the amounts allotted to the different roads under by-law 370 were reduced proportionately so that the total amount expended under the by-law shall be \$2700.

Mr. Rathwell gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to authorize the Reeve and Treasurer to borrow the sum of \$2700 at 6 percent interest to defray the expenditure under By-Law 370.

The council decided that the rate of pay under Good Roads by-law shall be as follows: Men \$3, Overseer \$4, Man & team \$5 and that not more than 15 cts per load shall be paid for gravel for use on the highways.

Mr. Rathwell then introduced By-Law No 377 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr Jamieson the By-law was read a first time.

The Clerk was instructed to order a Road Drag for James Headrick.

On motion of Mr Miller seconded by Mr Barr the blank in by-law No 377 was filled in with "\$2700" and the by-law was then read a second and third time short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr Jamieson seconded by Mr Rathwell the Treasurer was authorized to pay the road Commissioners the sums allotted to the respective roads under by-law No 370

The Clerk was instructed to order 8 sets of Culvert tile.

The sum of \$12⁵⁰ was granted for repairing road through lot 27 Con₃ provided Horton grant an equal amount for the same purpose

On motion of Mr. Miller seconded by Mr Rathwell the following accounts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for their payment:-
