

Foresters Falls July 3<sup>rd</sup> 1920

Council met here to-day all the members being present the Reeve in the chair.

The minutes of the last two meetings of Council were read and adopted.

On motion of Mr Millar, seconded by Mr Barr. By-Law No. 370 as approved by the Minister of Lands Forests and Mines was read a third time and finally passed.

Mr Rathwell gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to allow the Queens Line Telephone Association the privilege of using certain roads as designated in by-law on which to erect Telephone poles.

On motion of Mr Barr seconded by Mr Jamieson the sum of \$25<sup>00</sup> was granted towards repairing town line between Ross and Westmeath opposite Cor. 1 E.M.L.

The Council decided to defer the consideration of Dr. J. Brown's bill for services as M. O. H for 5 1/2 months of present year until their next meeting, the clerk in the meantime to communicate with the Provincial Board of Health regarding the matter.

Mr Rathwell then introduced by-law No 378 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr Jamieson the by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr. Barr a grant of \$25 was made to Joseph Jeffrey to repair road at Lot 19 Con 3.

The Clerk was instructed to order 3 Sets of Culvert-tile to be shipped to John H. Barr Cobden.

On motion of Mr. Millar seconded by Mr Barr, by-law No 378 was then read a second and third time short and finally passed.

On motion of Mr. Jamieson seconded by Mr. Millar, the following bills and accounts were accepted and orders drawn on the Treasurer for the payment thereof.

A regular Meeting of Council was held here this day all the members being present except Mr. Barw.

The Minutes of last Meeting of Council were read & approved and several communications received and considered.

On motion of Mr Millar seconded by Mr. Rathwell P. R. Prouder Treas was authorized to carry on the banking business of the Township with the Merchants Bank of Canada.

Mr Millar gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to authorize the Reeve and Treasurer to borrow the sum of \$1000 from the Merchants Bank to defray the current expenses of the Township.

Mr Millar then introduced by-law No 379 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr Rathwell the by-law was read a first time.

On motion of Mr Jamieson seconded by Rathwell, Mr Millar was instructed to examine road allowance between cons. 6 & 7 opposite Lot 5 and report at next meeting of Council. By-Law No 379 was then read a second and third time and finally passed.
