

Foresters Falls Dec 15<sup>th</sup> 1920

A regular meeting of Council was held here this day, all the members being present, the Reeve in the chair.

Mr Rathwell gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to make provision for holding the ensuing Municipal election.

The minutes of last meeting were read and approved and a number of Communications, bills and accounts presented and considered.

Mr Rathwell then introduced By-Law No 384 to make provision for holding the Municipal Election, and on his motion seconded by Mr. Barr, the by-law was read a first time.
