

## Foresters Falls

May 28/21

Minutes of Court of Revision held in village of Foresters Falls on above date all the members of Council being Present Mr Jamieson in the Chair after being duly sworn the Court proceeded to business as follows

Mr Dan Mc Cullough appealed against his assessment as being too high and on a motion by Mr. Mc Ewen seconded by A Rathwell his assessment was reduced \$200<sup>00</sup>

Mr Thos Sears appeal that his assessment was too high was considered and the assessment was sustained

on a motion by Mr Miller seconded by Mr Barr Mr Thos Wright was assessed \$800<sup>00</sup> for Part of Lot 6 in the 1st Concession 4 acres which had been omitted from the roll.

The assessor was instructed to assess the Bell Telephone Co Line from Cobden in an easterly direction to Foresters Falls and thence north to the Town line of Westmeath \$1300<sup>00</sup> which Part had been omitted from the Roll.

after making the necessary changes owing to change of ownership since the assessor had computed the roll of several lots the roll was accepted as correct and Court adjourned

The Council then met for general business with the Reeve in the Chair  
 A number of Communications were read and considered

Mr. C. Y. Coulter appeared before Council requesting the Council to have the fence removed from the Concession line between Concessions 3 x 4 opposite lots 14 x 15  
 on a motion by Mr Rathwell seconded by Mr Jameson a grant of \$15.00 was given Allan Shebark to repair Town Line opposite his lot on condition that Westman give the same amount.

The Clerk was instructed to notify Mr Ed Gibsin to remove his fence from road allowance between Concessions 3 x 4  
 on a motion by Mr Barr seconded by Mr Rathwell Mr McEwen was instructed to have the road opposite lots 14 x 15 Concessions 3 x 4 put in a passable condition. Cost of same not to exceed \$25.00

on a motion by Mr Miller seconded by Mr Barr Mr Rathwell was instructed to have town line between Ross & Bronly opposite lots 16 x 17 repaired. Ross Township share of cost not to exceed \$25.00

Mr Miller gave notice that at this meeting of Council he would introduce a By Law no 388 to authorize the Reeve & Treasurer to borrow the sum of \$3000.00 to defray the expenditure under By Law no 388

Mr Miller then introduced By Law no 388 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr Barr it was read a first time.

on a motion by Mr Jameson seconded by Mr Rathwell By Law no 388 was read a second and third time short & finally passed



on a motion by Jm Rathwell seconded by Mr Barr the Treasurer was authorized to pay the road Commissioners the sums allotted to the respective roads under By-Law no 380 as follows
