

Foresters Falls Oct 1st / 21

The Regular meeting of the Council of the Township of Ross was held here on the above date. Members present, the reeve, Councillors, Rathwell, Miller and Barr. The minutes of the previous ^{regular} meeting were read and approved. Communications were then read and considered.

Mr Clifford Johnston appeared before Council asking to have fence removed from road allowance between concessions three and four opposite lots 11, 12 and 13. After deliberation Council instructed the clerk to notify all concerned to have fence removed from right of way between concessions three and four opposite lots 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15.

Mr John Rose appeared before Council asking for grant on road from Haleys to Northcote. It was then moved by J. Barr seconded by Andrew Rathwell that a grant of \$25⁰⁰ be made, Mr Rose to be supervisor.

Andrew Rathwell gave notice that he would, at this meeting of Council, introduce a by-law to authorize and provide for the levying of all necessary rates for the current year.

Councillor Miller gave notice that he would, at this meeting of Council, introduce a by-law to authorize and provide for the improvement of certain main and leading roads in the year 1922 under the terms and conditions of the Colonization Roads Act.

Mr Rathwell then introduced by-law No 391 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by J. Barr, the by-law was read a first time.

Mr Miller then introduced by-law No 390 of which he had given notice and on his

motion seconded by Mr Rathwell the by-law was read a first time
