

Foresters Falls R.R. June 3<sup>rd</sup>/22

~~The~~ <sup>A</sup> regular meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross was held here on above date as a court of Revision. All members were present Mr. Jamieson in the Chair. After being duly sworn in the Court considered the following appeals.

John A. Plauant appeal on assessment of lot 24 and part of 25 in first con's. His assessment was reduced from \$600 to \$500. Walter Wright's assessment of \$1400 was sustained. Henry Jamieson's assessment of \$2700 on part of lot 10 and 11 in the tenth con's was reduced to 2500. It was then moved by D. McEwen seconded by A. Rathwell that the roll be accepted as revised.

Council met for general business at 11.30 A.M. Minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved. Bills of communication were read and considered. Mr. E. Dale appeared before Council asking to have a section of ground re-opened as a street at Haley's Station. Council decided to take no action at present. Council then adjourned for 1 hour.

On re-assembling Mr. F. J. Moxam appeared asking to have his assessment grouped for S.L. purposes. Council agreed to do so.

It was moved by A. Rathwell seconded by J. M. Jamieson that Council grant the sum of \$30.00 on road leading from carding mill to W<sup>o</sup> Byres. Carried. Mr. S. Johnston offered to put his own two teams on grade if Council will put on a team for 1/2 or 2 days to grade road leading out from his place toward Foresters Falls.

Mr. Jamieson gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a by-law to allow the New Line Telephone Association the privilege of using certain roads as designated in by-law on which to erect telephone poles. Mr. Jamieson then introduced by-law no 394 of which he had given notice

and on his motion seconded by A. Rathwell it was read a first time. On motion of R. Fraser seconded by J. H. Barr Bylaw no 394 was read a second and third time short and finally passed. The clerk was instructed to order six metal culverts for use on the roads.

On motion of J. M. Jamieson seconded by J. H. Barr the following bills were approved and orders drawn on Treasurer for payment of same.
