

Foresters Falls Oct 7th /22

The regular meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross was held here on the above date. All members present, The Reeve in the Chair. The minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved and signed by the Reeve. Communications were read and considered. Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling Mr J. H. Reynolds appeared, asking to have something done to stop the hauling of gravel, which was undermining his fence. Mr. Fraser was authorized to have fence moved to the proper line next to roadway. Mr. Jas Childerhouse appeared as spokesman for a delegation asking to have road improved on concession line in the first Concession E.M.T. Mr. McEwen drew attention to the fact that the fences on the right of way between Con 2 and 3 from lot 10 to lot 15 had not been moved as ordered by Council. Council decided not to take any action on matter today. The Clerk was instructed to order one 12" by 16' and one 15' by 16' culverts to be shipped to W^o Payne, Halcyon Sta. Ont.

Mr. Rathwell gave notice that he would, at this meeting of Council, introduce a bylaw to authorize and provide for the levying of all necessary rates for the present year.

Mr. Rathwell then introduced bylaw no 396 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by J. H. Barr, the bylaw was read a first time.
