

Foresters Falls Dec 15th /22.

A regular meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross was held here on above date. All members of Council present the Reeve in the chair. The minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved and signed by the Reeve. Communications were read and considered. Meeting then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling Rev. W. G. Wilson appeared looking for damages sustained to his car, by stone embedded in gravel opposite Charles Wate's farm.

Mr. Rathwell moved and was seconded by R. Fraser that the Council grant an order to Mr. Wilson for twenty five dollars, being half the amount of damage sustained on his car. Carried.

It was moved by J. M. Jamieson seconded by R. Fraser that Council make a grant of twenty five dollars to the North Renfrew Agriculture Society. Carried.

Mr. Rathwell was appointed to have the road, in lieu of sideroad, between lots 15 and 16 in 1st. Conis. brushed out.

Mr. Rathwell gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council, introduce a bylaw for the purpose of holding Municipal Elections and for the purpose of taking a vote on a site for the building of a new Town Hall, whether site should be at the village of Foresters Falls or on the Queens Line, and on his motion seconded by J. H. Bair the ~~bylaw was read a first time.~~

Mr. Rathwell then introduced Bylaw No 399 which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by J. H. Bair it was read a first time.
