

Foresters Falls Ont. Mch. 3/23

"Minutes of the third regular meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross held on Saturday the third day of March 1923."

Present, Councillors J. H. Barr, R. Fraser and J. Moxam.

It was moved by R. Fraser seconded by J. Moxam that J. H. Barr act as Chairman. Carried.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read. On motion of J. Moxam seconded by R. Fraser the minutes as read were received and confirmed.

Correspondence and communications were then read and considered.

Council then adjourned for one hour.

\* On re-assembling, it was moved by R. Fraser seconded by J. Moxam that the Reeve and Secretary be authorized to convey by deed to J. H. Reynolds that part of the right of way between lots 8 and 9 opposite lots 6 and north half of 7. Carried.

It was then moved by R. Fraser seconded by J. Moxam that Mr. Thomas Moxam be authorized to put up notices and receive tenders for the purchase of the Old Town Hall at Foresters Falls. The successful tender to be required to clean up all rubbish and material except what stone there might be. Carried.

It was moved by J. Moxam seconded by R. Fraser that the following bills and accounts be accepted and orders drawn on treasurer for payment thereof. Carried.
