

Foresters Falls Ont. May 5<sup>th</sup> /23.

The regular meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross was held here on the above date. Council first assembled as a "Court of Revision" to hear appeals for revisions of assessment.

"Minutes of Court of Revision".

All members of Council being present and having taken the declaration of office they proceeded to consider the only appeal that had been entered, that of A. J. Armstrong of Arnprior, Ont, who claimed to be too lightly assessed. After consideration it was moved by R. Fraser seconded by A. Wallace that the total assessment be reduced from \$1050 to 1000. Carried. The reduction of \$50 was to be applied against 3/4 acre lot in lot 14. The Court then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling, the roll was carefully gone over and some names transferred from Part 1 to Part 2. On motion of J. Ingham seconded by J. H. Baird the roll was then accepted as revised and the clerk was instructed to make the necessary changes.

Council then opened for ordinary business. The minutes of last regular meeting were read & approved and signed by the Reeve.

It was moved by R. Fraser seconded by J. H. Baird that Jos. Bennett be granted \$5.00 for use of winter road and fixing fences. Carried.

It was then moved by J. Ingham seconded by J. H. Baird that Council grant \$3.00 to pull the stumps on Concession Line between 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Con. opposite lot 13 and level top of hill. Carried.

\* It was moved by J. Ingham seconded by A. Wallace that Messrs. Jamieson and Fraser act as a committee to arrange with Mr. Reynolds for getting a portion of S 1/2 of lot 4 in 6<sup>th</sup> Con. E. M. L. in line of fence line between lots 5 & 6 in 6<sup>th</sup> Con. E. M. L. Carried.

It was then moved by R. Fraser seconded by
