

Forester Falls R. P. Oct 6th /23.

The regular monthly meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross was held here on above date. all members present the ^{the chair} minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved and signed by the Reeve.

Councillors Moxam and Fraser ^{who} were appointed a Committee to deal with G. Bennett re securing a piece of land for road through lot 5 box 7. reported as follows.

Bennett agreed to give a strip 1150 feet long by 12 feet wide at \$75 per acre.

Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling J. Moxam gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council, introduce a by-law, to authorize and provide for the levying of all necessary rates for the present year.

Mr. Moxam then introduced bylaw No 403 of which he had already given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr. Wallace, the bylaw was read a first time.

On motion of R. Fraser seconded by A. Wallace the blanks in Bylaw No 403 were filled in as follows:-

It was moved by R. Fraser seconded by A. Wallace that J. Moran be authorized to have culvert on road leading into the Old Elliott place, repaired.

On motion of A. Wallace seconded by R. Fraser, the following bills and accounts were accepted and orders drawn on treasurer for payment of same.
