

Foresters Falls Ont 20010/23

The regular monthly meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross was held here on the above date.

Members present, Councillors Fraser, Noxam and Wallace. Councillor Barr was elected Chairman.

Minutes of last regular meeting were read and approved and signed by Acting Reeve.

Communications were read and considered.

Alex Bennett appeared before Council asking to have the consideration of Council regarding the water situation on lot 10 in 6th concession.

Council then adjourned for one hour ^{George Jamieson being present took the Chair}

On reassembling Councillor Fraser gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw to authorize and provide for the ^{construction and} improvement of certain main and leading roads in the Township for the year 1924, under the terms and conditions of the Colonization Roads Act.

Mr. Hilliard Guest appeared before Council asking for a Bylaw to permit the Queens Line Telephone Association to operate a Telephone line on the route of the Bell Telephone Company's line from Cobden to Foresters Falls and Beachburg.

Mr. Noxam gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw to authorize and provide for the operation by the Queens Line Telephone Association of a Telephone line on the route of the Bell Telephone Company's line from Cobden to Foresters Falls and on to Beachburg.

It was moved by H. Barr and seconded by R. Fraser that the Clerk be instructed to notify the parties interested in the award ditch on Boris line between Boris 5 and 6 opposite lots 8 and 9 to have their parts of said ditch cleaned out within 30 days and if not so done that the Council will call on the County Engineer to have the same done. Also that

that Mr. Barr report on the same at next meeting of Council. Carried.

Mr. Moxam then introduced Bylaw No 404 of which he had previously given notice and on his motion seconded by R. Fraser it was read a first time.

Mr. Barr gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a Bylaw to authorize and provide for the appointment of a "Tax Collector" for the Township for the current year.

It was moved by R. Fraser seconded by Moxam that Revere Jamieson and Councillors Barr and Wallace be a committee to undertake an agreement between the parties concerned in the water originating on lot 10 in 5th Con^v. Carried.

Councillor Fraser then introduced Bylaw No 405 of which he had previously given notice and on his motion seconded by G. Wallace it was read a first time.

It was moved by R. Fraser seconded by J. Moxam that Council grant the sum of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars to the Foresters Falls Library. Carried.

Mr. Barr then introduced Bylaw No 406 of which he had previously given notice and on his motion seconded by J. Moxam it was read a first time.

It was moved by J. Moxam seconded by R. Fraser that Council grant the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars toward the Pembroke Cottage Hospital. Carried.

On motion of G. Wallace seconded by Mr. Barr Bylaw No 404 was then read a second and a third time short and finally passed.

On motion of R. Fraser seconded by G. Wallace the blanks in Bylaw No 405 were filled in as follows:-

- Road No 2, - Between concessions 2 and 3 opposite
lots 25, 26 and 27. 200.00
- Road No 3, - Road leading through 1st Con's E. M.L. beginning
at Lot 1 and continuing through northward. 300.00
- Road No 4, - Forced road beginning at Lot 5 ^{8th Con's} and
running to Down line of Ross & Westmeath 200.00
- Road No 5, - Cross line between lots 5 & 6 to Con's 7 & 8 E. M.L. 200.00
- Road No 6, - Road through Lot 11 & 12 in 11th Con's. 200.00
- Road No 7, - Cross line between lots 10 & 11 opposite
concessions 7 & 8 & 9. 200.00
- Road No 8, - Cross line between lots 15 & 16 opposite
concessions 7 and 8. 500.00
- Road No 9, - Down line between Ross & Bromley from Lot 7
to Lot 10 and along Cross line between lots 10
and 11 to 2nd concession. 300.00
- Road No 10, - Down line between Ross and Westmeath through
opposite Con's 1 W. M. L. 200.00
- Road No 12, - ^{Forced road in lieu of} Cross line between lots 15 & 16 in Con's 2. 200.00

And Bylaw was then read a second time.

On motion of G. Wallace seconded by R. Fraser
blanks in bylaw no 406 were filled in with the
name of Stephen Gilmore as Tax collector for 1923
and read a second and a third time short and
finally passed.
