

Foresters Falls Jan 14/24

The first Regular Meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross for the year 1924 was held in the Orange Hall at Foresters Falls on Monday Jan 14th. Present J. M. Jamieson Reeve & Councillors elect Thomas Moram, Albert Wallace, John Wilson and Donald McDonald. The members of Council having taken the necessary declarations of office. The Minutes of last Regular Meeting were read approved and signed. Correspondence was then read and given consideration. Council adjourned for one hour.
