Council then adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling it was moved by H. Wallace seconded by D. McDonald that this Council remit the sum of Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars on the Medical Health Account of W^o Brussow. Carried.

It was moved by J. Wilson seconded by H. Wallace that Mrs. ~~T. Moxam~~ Moxam be appointed Trust Office for 1924 at a salary of \$25.00. Carried, this to be included in Bylaw No 408.

It was moved by D. McDonald seconded by T. Moxam that Mr. Hugh Wilson be appointed Assessor for 1924 at a salary of \$90.00. This also to be included in Bylaw No 408. Carried.

It was moved by J. Wilson seconded by H. Wallace that the Clerk be authorized to write the board of Railway Commissioners to try and establish the responsibility for a horse being killed on the right of way of the Canadian National Ry by one of their trains. Carried.

It was moved by T. Moxam seconded by J. Wilson that the following bills and accounts having been accepted, orders be drawn on Treasurer for payment of same, -
