

Foresters Falls Mar 1<sup>st</sup> 1924

The third Regular meeting of the Council of Ross was held here on the above date, present Reeve Jamieson and Councillors Motam, Wallace & McDonald, The Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read approved and signed. It was moved by T. Motam sec. by D. McDonald that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favor of Stephen Gilmour for \$100.<sup>00</sup> salary as Collector and 6.25 for postage total 106.25 carried Council. adjourned for one hour. On reassembling Councillor John Wilson was present. Mr. Samuel McLaren appeared before Council as a representative of Bromley Council soliciting the cooperation and assistance of this Township in improving the Town Line between Ross and Bromley. Council promised consideration. The Clerk was instructed by Council to write the Clerk of Bromley re. expenditure of Colonization Road money on the Townline between the two townships. It was moved by D. McDonald seconded by A. Wallace that this Council make a grant of \$20.<sup>00</sup> to the Children's Shelter at Renfrew carried

On motion of A. Wallace seconded by D. McDonald the following bills and accounts were approved and orders drawn on the Treasurer in payment of the same
