The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Hall here on above date as a duly constituted Court of Revision with the Rev. J. M. Jamieson acting as Chairman. There was an appeal from Mr. J. H. Byce against his assessment as being too high. After due consideration ~~the Council~~ ^{the Court} reduced Mr. Byces assessment by \$400. This was the only appeal sent in some alterations due to changes of ownership having been made. On motion of Mr. Moxam seconded by Mr. Wallace the Roll as revised was approved and accepted. The Council then opened for the General business of the Township. Minutes of last Regular Meeting were read approved and signed by the Rev. On reassembling Mr. Weir representative of Canada Ingot Iron Co addressed Council as to the merits of the products of his Company. Council promised due consideration.

Mr. Laughlin Curry appeared asking for the amount of money coming from Statute Labor in Road Div 18 for the years 1923 & 1924 and balance from 1922.

Mr. Hugh Pettigrew & S. Murdoch asked Council for a grant to cut down hill on road leading to their place. Council suggested that this job be included in the Colonization Roads Bylaw for next year.

Mr S. A. Johnston asked grant to fence the new road on the 6th line. Council granted sum of \$30. Moved by J. Wilson see by D McDonald that Council grant sum of \$10 to blast out rock on proof line between lots 10 & 11 in 1st Con.

Moved by A. Wallace seconded by J. Wilson that the taxes for 1915 on the W $\frac{1}{2}$ & N $\frac{1}{2}$ of lot 4 in 3rd Con E. M. L. be cancelled, and that notice of this resolution be sent to County Treasurer

Moved by T. Mocam see by D McDonald that Council grant the sum of \$20 to Ross School Fair Carried

Moved by T. Mocam seconded by A. Wallace that bylaw No 405 re Col. Roads be read a third time and finally passed

Mr Mocam gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw authorizing the Clerk & Treasurer to borrow up to \$2400 for work on Roads under bylaw 406

Moved by D. McDonald see by A Wallace that the rate of pay by the Tp on good roads be for man & team 5.00 man 2.50 overseer 4.00 Carried

Mr Mocam then introduced bylaw No 410 of which he had given notice, and on his motion see by A Wallace it was read a first time. On motion of Wilson see by McDonald bylaw no 410 was then read a 2nd & 3rd time short and finally passed
