

Foresters Falls January 12th 1925

The first Regular Meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross for the year 1925 was held in the hall here on Jan 12th. Present Reeve J. M. Jamieson and Councillors Thomas Moxam, Albert Wallace, John Wilson and Donald McDonald. The members of Council having taken the necessary declaration of office the minutes of last Regular Meeting were read approved and signed. Correspondence was then read and given consideration. Council adjourned for one hour. On reassembling Mr Moxam gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw for the purpose of paying out certain sums of money. Mr McDonald gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw for the purpose of appointing township officers for the year 1925. Mr Moxam then introduced bylaw No (416) of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by J. Wilson it was read a first time. Mr McDonald then introduced bylaw No (418) of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by A. Wallace it was read a first time, on motion of Mr McDonald sec. by Mr Wilson bylaw No (416) was then read a second and third time short and finally passed. The blanks in bylaw No (418) were filled in as follows Clerk W^m J. Oates at a salary of \$250. W. R. Kirk & W. S. Coleman auditors at a salary of \$ each Duncan M^{rs} Owen salary \$75. Truant Officer Mrs Thos. Moxam salary \$25 assessor Jas. A. Wright at a salary of \$90.
