

Foresters Falls April 4th 1925

A Regular Meeting of The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross was held in The Hall here on the above date present the Reeve and Councillors Wallace Motam & Wilson

The Minutes of last Regular Meeting were read approved and signed

Mr. Dan McCullough & Irvine Deane appeared before Council asking to have Bylaw No 297 amended to allow the Zion Tel. Co to extend their pole line along Road allowance between Con' 4 & 5 opposite lots 8 & 9 Council adjourned

On reassembling Mr Wallace gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a Bylaw to amend Bylaw No 297 to allow Zion Tel Co to extend their pole line along Public Highway between Con' 4 & 5 opposite lots 8 & 9.

Mr Motam gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a Bylaw to authorize The Halcyon Station Telephone Co. to construct and maintain Telephone poles and wires on certain highways in the Township of Ross, shown on a map filed with the Council by the secretary of said Telephone Co

Mr Wallace then introduced bylaw No 419 of which he had given notice and on his motion sec by J. Wilson it was read a first time

Mr Motam then introduced bylaw No 417 of which he had already given notice and on his motion sec by J. Wilson it was read a first time. On motion of John Wilson seconded by J. Motam Bylaw No 419 was read a 2nd & 3rd time short and finally passed

On Motion of A Wallace seconded by J Motam Bylaw No 418 was read a second and 3rd time short and finally passed. The name of Irvine Deane was substituted for that of Ephraim McEwen as pathmaster for 1925

It was moved by J. Wilson seconded by J Motam that

the Municipality become purchasers of lands sold for taxes that do not bring the full amount of taxes and expenses against them at the ensuing County Tax Sale.

It was moved by A. Wallace sec by T. Moxam that the following bills and accounts be approved and orders drawn on the Treasurer in payment of same

Mr John Dretton asked Council to supply 4" tile to cross the road allowance between Concessions 576 opposite lot 9. Council agreed to furnish tile for said purpose Mr Dretton agreeing to assume all responsibility that may be incurred thereby. The name of John Code was substituted
