

Foresters Falls June 6<sup>th</sup> 1925

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met & in the hall here on above date as a duly constituted Court of Revision, with the Reeve J. M. Jamieson acting as chairman

There was an appeal from A. J. Armstrong against the assessment on V.L. No 7 in the 8<sup>th</sup> Con, as being too high, also an appeal from Mr Fred Schwartz against the assessment on the West half of 11 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Concession. After due consideration of the fore mentioned assessments as to their equality with others assessments, It was moved by John Wilson seconded by T. McCom <sup>and carried</sup> that the assessment on V.L. 7 in the 8<sup>th</sup> Con be reduced by \$100. It was moved by D. McDonald and seconded by J. Wilson <sup>and carried</sup> that the assessment on West 1/2 of 11 in 2<sup>nd</sup> Con, be reduced by \$250 (50 on buildings and 200 on land). The Court then carefully examined the assessment-roll making the necessary change due to change of ownership since date of assessment, adding eligible names and erasing others

The assessment-Roll as revised was accepted and the Court <sup>adjourned</sup> Council ~~was~~ reassembled for general business at 10<sup>th</sup> The Minutes of last Regular Meeting were read, approved and duly signed. Mr Lorenzo Edmunds appeared looking to have road leading through his place closed up by the Council. John McLean asked assistance to fix up road along by W<sup>m</sup> Burton's place. Council promised consideration. Council approved basis of <sup>valuation</sup> payment adopted by Mr McLean in fixing amount of payment for lambs and sheep killed or worried by dogs. W<sup>m</sup> Cummings appeared before Council asking for a grant to improve road opposite his place. Council instructed Mr. Wilson to visit the place and use his own judgment as to what should be done.

Mr Hugh Pettigrew and Mr. Samuel Murdoch appeared asking to have Council give consideration to the road at Hill on Con Con 10 opposite lot 12. It was moved by D. McDonald seconded by J. Wilson and carried that Messrs Jamieson and McCom visit the ground and

and decide what is best to be done

Mr Samuel C Johnston appeared asking grant to fix road on Zion Line near his place. Council advised to pass it over as much as possible. and have Colonization Road Grant made on it next year

It was moved by A Wallace sec. by J. Wilson, <sup>and carried</sup> that Col. Roads by Law No 415 be now brought forward and given its third reading and finally passed

Mr Motam gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw authorizing the Revere and Treasurer to borrow up to the sum of (\$3000) Three Thousand Dollars to meet payments for work done under bylaw<sup>415</sup>

Mr. Motam then introduced bylaw No 420 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by A. Wallace it was read a first time

On motion of J. Wilson seconded by D. McDonald bylaw No 420 was then read a second and third time short and finally passed

The Clerk was instructed by Council to order 2 one team man graders. The Clerk was also instructed to write the Municipal World re. C.P. R claims of payment for clearing certain highway crossings of snow and ice during winter 1925

On motion of A Wallace sec by D McDonald the following bills were approved and orders drawn on the Treas in payment from
