R. asking them to state by what authority they made claim against the Township of Ross for clearing snow & ice from certain Railway Crossings in the Township of Ross also the Clerk was instructed to order a couple of repair pieces for the maintenance graders purchased from the Sawyer Massey Co.

Moved by D. McDonald sec by J. Wilson that the Clerk be instructed to meet a representative from Horton to reconsider the equalization of the assessment of those parts of each Township that are included in Union School Section No 3.
