

Foresters Falls Sept 5th 1925

A Regular Meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross was held in the Hall here on the above date, with Councillors Wilson, McDonald, Moxam and the Reeve present. Minutes of last Regular Meeting were read approved and signed by the Reeve. Communications

Bills and accounts were then read and considered. After adjournment council resumed at 1 P. M. Mr. Moxam gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw for the purpose of levying the necessary rates for County Township, General School rate, debenture rate for S.S. No 6 and the local school rates.

It was moved by J. McDonald seconded by J. Moxam that Council make a grant of \$50 to Cobden Agr. Society and a similar grant to the North Reapers Agr. Society.

It was moved by J. McDonald seconded by John Wilson that the Clerk be instructed to get legal advice re charge accounts of certain C.P.R. Railway Crossings.

It was moved by J. Moxam seconded by J. Wilson that Dr. E. C. Ferrill be appointed Medical Health Officer ^{on some farms as his predecessor} for the Township of Ross in place of Dr. Mick resigned.

Mr. Moxam then introduced bylaw No 421 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by J. McDonald it was read a first time.

On motion of J. Wilson seconded by A. Wallace the blanks in Bylaw No 421 were filled in as follows:
