

Foresters Falls Jan 11 1926

A Regular Meeting of the Municipal Council the first for the present year was held here this day. The Reeve and all the members of last years Council having been reelected by acclamation made the usual declaration of office and took their seats at the Council Board.

The minutes of last Regular meeting of Council were read approved and duly signed.

Communications, bills, and accounts were presented and given consideration.

Dan McDonald gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw to authorize and provide for the payment of salaries, bills and accounts and all other necessary expenditures for the present year.

Thomas Moxam gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw for the appointment of Township officers for the present year.

Mr McDonald then introduced bylaw No. (424) of which he had given notice and on his motion see by Albert Wallace it was read a first time. Mr Moxam then introduced bylaw No. (425) of which he had given notice and on his motion see by John Wilson it was read a first time. Council adjourned till 1 P. M.

On reassembling it was moved by J. Moxam see by A. Wallace that the Cobden Sun get the printing for the Township to do the same work as last year for the sum of \$60.

On Motion of J. Moxam see by J. Wilson bylaw No 424 was read a second and third time short and finally passed.
