A Regular Meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross was held in the Orange Hall here on.... The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met in the Hall here on date as above as a duly constituted Court of Revision with the Reeve J. M. Jamieson acting as Chairman. There was an appeal from Mr. Herbert Bilson against his assessment as being too high on buildings, also an appeal from Mr. Henry Buttle against his assessment as being too high. After having given consideration to those appeals and comparing the assessment with others it was moved by A. Wallace see by J. Wilson that the assessment of H. Bilson be reduced \$300 on buildings. It was moved by D. McDonald and see by John Wilson that the assessment of H. Buttle be reduced \$200 on the land carried this being all the appeals before the court the assessment Roll was gone over and the necessary changes made with respect to change of ownership.

It was moved by D. McDonald see by A. Wallace that the Roll as revised be approved and accepted. Council then adjourned sine die <sup>carried</sup>

At 1 P.M. Council met for the transactions of general business of the Township. The Reeve in the chair. Minutes of last Regular Meeting were read approved and signed by the Reeve.
