

Foresters Falls July 3<sup>rd</sup>/26

A Regular meeting of the Municipal Council was held in the hall on the above date present the Reeve and Councillors Wallace McDonald & Wilson. Minutes of last Regular Meeting were approved as read and signed by the Reeve.

Correspondence and accounts were read and considered. On motion of D. McDonald see J. Wilson. The clerk was instructed to correct an error in the Roll with respect to the business assessment of W.S. Coleman. On reassembling at one o'clock on motion of D. McDonald see by J. Wilson. P. S. S. No 6. was granted the use of the Township Hall site as a playground for one year. The school board to have the privilege of removing any fences they may erect when through making use the grounds.

Moved by J. Wilson see by A. Wallace that a grant of Twenty Dollars be made to the Ross school Fair. Car John Wilson gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-law authorizing the Reeve and Treasurer to borrow up to \$345.00 from the bank to meet current expenditure and Col. Road accounts.
