

Foresters Falls Nov 6th 1926

A Regular Meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross was held in the Orange Hall here on the above date with a full Council present.

The Minutes of the last Regular Meeting were read approved and signed by the Reeve. The correspondence was then read and considered. The Clerk was instructed to write the Dept. of Public Highways for statement of gravel taken by the Township from the Government ^{gravel}. Council adjourned for one hour.

On re-assembling Mr. Nelson Bell appeared before Council soliciting a grant in aid of Foresters Falls Public Library.

Mr. McDonald gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a by-law to authorize and provide for the construction and improvement of certain main and leading roads in the Township in the year 1927 under the terms and conditions of the Colonization Roads Act.

It was moved by D. McDonald sec by J. Wilson that Council make a grant in favor of Foresters Falls Public Library of \$25 carried.

Mr. McDonald then introduced By-law No (429) of which he had given notice and on his motion sec by A. Wallace it was read a first time.

On motion of John Wilson sec by T. Moxam the blanks in By-law No (429) were filled in as follows:
