

Foresters Falls May 7 - 1927

A Regular Meeting of the Municipal Council of Ross was held here on above date

The Minutes of last Regular Meeting were read approved and duly signed

Communications were read and accounts presented Mr. George Ferguson appeared looking for money to spend on Fourth Line. Council agreed to furnish a culvert and repairs for another and to grade It was moved by Wallace see by Moxam that the Clerk write W.A. Biggs Co. Treas. authorizing him to accept the taxes for 1925 on an assessment of \$300 being that portion of White Granite Co. Ltd. Mrs D. Morley & Mrs John Herrow appeared asking Council to provide site for community Hall Council promised consideration

Mr Thos O'Gibson and Mr Henry Gibson appeared looking for grant on road at Creek leading in to their place. Council promised to go and look the ground over. . . . Moved by Wallace see by Wilson that the Council take protection from The Globe Indemnity Co from liability for accidents happening on Township Roads carried unanimously

As the Col. Roads Dept had reduced the amount asked for in By-law No 429 by \$1250. The By-law was amended as follows

 The Court then adjourned sine die
 After dinner the Council visited the road leading
 in to Don. McCaskill's place, ^{which is in bad shape} after which they
 met in the hall for the transaction of the General
 Business of the Township.

 Mr. J. J. Logan appeared before Council looking
 to have culvert leading in to his place repaired
 Mr. Wallace was appointed to visit this road
 and have culvert repaired as well as a washout
