

Foresters Falls Dec 15 - 27

A Regular Meeting of the Municipal Council of Ross was held in the Hall here on above date with all the members of Council present. The Minutes of last Regular Meeting were read approved and signed. Communications were read and considered. Mr. Thos. Rollins appeared looking to get 2 culverts for his road div. and Geo Ferguson " looking to get 2 culverts on 4th line one opp lot 12 & 1 opp lot 13. Mr. McDonald gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-law to authorize and provide for the construction and improvement of certain main and leading roads in the Township Under the terms and conditions of the Colonization Roads Act. Mr. Wallace gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-law to make provision for holding the ensuing Municipal Elections. The Clerk was instructed to send expense acc of Prov. Police Officer Henry to County Clerk for readjustment.

Mr. McDonald then introduced By-law No (437) of which he had given notice and on his motion sec by J. Wilson it was read a first time. Mr. Wallace then introduced By-law No (438) of which he had given notice and on his motion sec. by J. Mearns it was read a first time. On motion of J. Motam sec. by J.
