

Foresters Falls Jan 9th 1928

The first Regular Meeting of the Municipal Council of the Township of Ross for the present year was held in the Orange Hall here on above date. The Council having been elected by acclamation the different members took their declarations of qualification and of Office and took their seats. The Minutes of last Regular Meeting were read approved and duly signed. Correspondence was read and considered.

After adjournment the Council reassembled at 1 P.M. Mr. Mocam gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-law to provide for the appointment of Township Officers for the year 1928.

Mr. Wallace gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-law to authorize and provide for the payment of salaries bills and accounts and all other necessary expenditures for the present year.
