

H. Falls, June 2nd 1928

The Municipal Council of the Township of Ross met on date as above as a duly constituted Court of Revision with Revere Jamieson in the Chair. There were three appeals as follows J. A. Armstrong assessed too high, John H. Byce assessed too high and John D. Black assessed too high after due consideration it was moved by John Wilson see by T. Moran that the assessment of John H. Byce be reduced 300.⁰⁰ carried it was moved by A. Wallace see by D. Mc Donald that the assessment of J. A. Armstrong & John D. Black be sustained as per assessment Roll

The Court then went through the assessment Roll erasing the names of deceased and making other changes due to changes of ownership etc

After adjournment for one hour Mr F. J. Moran appeared before Council looking for help to fix culvert at Movement Church Luere's Lane.

Council did not think that they were responsible as they had agreed to pay Mr Edward Pettigrew for building culvert and for cedar and he to be respon^{sible} for culvert

Clerk was instructed to write Cobden Council that Ross Council agree to take over road along east side of Logans Lake for the sum of \$1250.⁰⁰ if Cobden Council will contract not to raise the level of the water above a point or mark on the dam that would raise the level of the water above the present low part of road on Hugh Logans farm

Resolution of Mr D. Mc Donald gave notice that he would at this present meeting of Council introduce a by-law authorizing the Revere and Treasurer to borrow up to the sum of Three Thousand Four Hundred dollars \$3400.⁰⁰ to pay on Colonization

road work Mr McDonald then introduced
 By-law (No. 441) of which he had given notice and on
 his motion see by A. Wallace it was read a first time
 on motion of T. Moxam see by J. Wilson By-law No 441
 was read a second and third time short and finally passed.
 On motion of J. Wilson see by T. Moxam the following
