

F Falls July 7 1928

The regular meeting of the municipal Council of the township of Ross was held here on the above date with the full Council present. Minutes of last regular meeting were read proved and duly ~~signed~~ signed.

Mr Cook, agent for the Globe Indemnity Company was present in the interests of his Company. Council put on insurance against accidents happening on township roads within the municipality for the current year. Mr Ed. Pettigrew and Mr James A. Bonnet appeared before Council asking to have something done with road ditch opposite their places. Council promised to look into the matter.

~~Mr J. J. Sagan and Walter Power were present and were advised to spend money granted on township roads.~~

Mr James Rankin was present to have a talk with Council re. the enforcement of the weed control Act. Council advised him to use his own judgment without being too drastic. Council promised to give J. J. Sagan a culvert near his place.

Mr Macdonald gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw to amend bylaw no 439.

Mr Wilson gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw to amend bylaw no 120.

Mr Macdonald then introduced bylaw 442 of which he had given notice. And on his motion seconded by J. Inozam it was read a first time.

Mr Wilson then introduced bylaw 443 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by A Wallace it was read a first time.

Bylaw no 438 was amended by substituting the name of Harry Chiffelrose as poundkeeper in place of George Collins and on motion of A Wallace seconded by T Moyam it was read a second and third time short and ~~past~~.

Bylaw No 120 was amended by adding the words in this municipality after the word indecency in section one and by substituting for section two the following that it shall not be lawful to expose ~~the~~ person or perform any other indecent immoral or scandalous action in any street highway or ^{public place} within this municipality. On motion of T Moyam seconded by D Macdonald amending bylaw No 443 was then read a second and third time short and finally past.

On motion of A Wallace seconded by J Wilson the following bills were approved and orders drawn on the treasurer in payment of same.
