It was moved by Mcnam see by Wallace that Mr. D. J. McLaren be our collector of taxes for 1928 Moved by Wilson see by Wallace that this Council recommend Frank McIntyre for the office of Commissioner or Justice of the Peace

J. Mcnam gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a By-law to provide for the borrowing from the province of up to \$200,000.00 for the purpose of tile drainage

Mr. Mcnam then introduced By-law No 440 of which he had given notice and on his motion see by Wallace it was read a first time on motion of Wallace see by Wilson By-law No 440 was read a second & third time short & finally passed

Moved by Wallace see by Wilson that notice of the passing of By-law No 440 be pub. in the Cobden Sun for three issues It was moved & see & passed that the following accounts be passed and orders made on the Treasurer
