

Foresters Falls Dec 15 1928

The regular meeting of the council was held at Foresters Falls on above date. Present councillors Wilson Mozam McDonald and Wallace. Mr Wilson in the chair Minutes of last regular meeting read approved and signed. A number of communications were read and considered. Mr W<sup>m</sup> Gibson appeared before council asking for Colonization Ed. Grant also Messrs Gilmour, Thompson and Cole Council promised consideration Moved by Mr McDonald seconded by Mr Wallace that council adjourn for one hour.

Council reassembled with the reeve in the chair all the members present. The clerk was instructed to write to Mr Neville re taking of affidavit in regard to sheep killed by dogs also to Mr Crozier re report on sheep killed by dogs. Mr Mozam gave notice that he would at this meeting of the council introduce a by-law designating certain roads to be improved under the colonization roads act. Mr Wallace gave notice that he would at this meeting introduce a bylaw to make provision for holding of ensuing Municipal election. Mr. S. Johnston appeared before council looking for grant on road. Council promised consideration of same. Messrs E. B. Bulmer and F. McIntyre appeared before council on behalf of S. S. Nob asking for an increase of \$100 in the grants to the salaries of teachers in this school. As the rates had been struck for the year and the assessment roll was in the hands of the collector Council advised them to take matter up with 1929 council at the January meeting. Mr Mozam then introduced bylaw No ~~459~~ 4468 of which he had given notice and on

his motion seconded by Mr Wilson it was read a first time. (On motion of Mr McDonald seconded by Mr Wilson it) Mr Wallace then introduced bylaw No ~~434~~<sup>446</sup> of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr Wilson it was read a first time.
