A Regular Meeting of Ross Municipal Council was held in the Orange Hall here on above date with a full Council present. Minutes of last Regular Meeting were read approved and duly signed.

Communications bills & accounts were presented and given consideration.

Dr. Alexander appeared before Council looking for a grant to North Rempew Fall Fair it was moved seconded and carried unanimously that a grant of \$50 be made to Beachburg Fair.

It was moved <sup>by</sup> ~~see~~ and carried that Mrs Lydia M<sup>rs</sup> Law be reappointed as School Attendance Officer.

Mr L. Curry Mr S. Murdoch & Mr H. Pettigrew appeared asking to have deed of Town Hall site made in favor of Orange Lodge which site had been bargained for some time ago. The Clerk was instructed to have deed made out as requested.

Mr Pettigrew appeared looking to have a bridge on road leading along the 10<sup>th</sup> Con line ~~this~~ repaired. Council directed to have a couple of large cedars placed along the side as a protection.

Mr. Wallace gave notice that he would at the meeting of Council introduce a By-law for holding the coming Municipal Elections.

The Clerk was instructed to write <sup>in name of Municipality</sup> the Co Treasurer to have deeds made out for the different properties taken over by the Municipality for taxes at the tax sales in 1925 & 1928 and not since redeemed.
