

Foresters Falls June 7<sup>th</sup> 1930  
 The Municipal Council of the Tp. of Ross  
 met on above date as a duly constituted Court  
 of Revision with The Revere Mr Jamieson  
 acting as Chairman and Councillors Jeffrey,  
 Wallace & Mocam present.

The following appeals against their assessment  
 were made by Mrs John Dretton, Edward Pattigren  
 Wm Simpson Mrs Merchant, Walter Wright  
 John R. Byce, Mulburn Jeffrey & John Coiro  
 The ground of appeal in each case was that they  
 had been assessed too high in comparison with  
 their neighbors After questions to the appealing  
 ratepayers and giving the cases their best consideration  
 The Court decided as follows.

That the assessment ~~of~~ on the W<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, S<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, 4 in 3,  
 and owned by W. Simpson be reduced from \$1000<sup>00</sup>  
 to \$700<sup>00</sup> and that the assessment on the other lots  
 appealed remain as placed by the assessor. It was  
 granted J. R. Byce to have an assessment  
 of \$200 on 4 acres pt lot 10 Con 11 be assessed  
 together with bal of same in Con 11

It was moved by T. Jeffrey sec by A Wallace  
 that this Court of Revision do now adjourn to meet  
 the first Sat in July to go over the assessment Roll  
 and add names that should be on and to remove others  
 Messrs J. E. Waite & Hugh Gordon waited on Council  
 to find what ~~is~~ Statute Labor money was due <sup>Byrd Div. 18</sup>  
 Moved by T. Jeffrey sec by A Wallace that Mocam &  
 Wilson visit road on town Line Ross & Westmoreland in  
 the 3<sup>rd</sup> Con<sup>no</sup> and report at next Regular Meeting  
 Mr Wallace gave notice that he would at this  
 meeting of Council introduce a by-law to authorize  
 the Revere & Treasurer to borrow from the Bank up to  
 the sum of \$5,000<sup>00</sup>

Mr. Wallace then introduced by-law No (456) of  
 which he had given notice and on his motion  
 sec by J. Mocam it was read a first time

By-law No (45-6) was then read a second &  
Third time short & finally passed
