

Foresters Falls Dec 15 / 30

A Regular Meeting of Ross Municipal Council was held here on above date. Present acting Re Chairman T. Moran & Councillors Wilson, Wallace and Jeffrey. The Minutes of last Regular meeting were read approved and duly signed. Communications, bills and accounts were read and considered. Mr Samuel A Johnston & Harris were looking for refund of statute labor which they claimed they had performed.

Mrs Geo Rankin was reappointed as transient Officer for 1931 and Mr James Rankin was reappointed as weed Inspector.

Mr. A. Wallace gave notice that he would at next Meeting of Council introduce Colonization road by-law. A By-Law No 460 ^{passed and} was signed by the Reeve & Clerks granting the Pot Telephone Co the privilege of using the Highway to erect poles and stretch wires thereon.
