

Foresters Falls, Dec. 15, 1931.

A regular meeting of Council was held on the above date with all <sup>the Council</sup> Councilors present except Councilor Jeffery.

Minutes of the November meeting were read approved and duly signed.

Communications, bills and accounts were read and considered.

Council adjourned for one hour.

Wetton gave notice that he would at the meeting of Council, introduce a by-law conveying to Ethel Church, a portion of highway by Concession no. 111 the east half, lot 21.

Sheehan then introduced by-law #70 of which he had given notice. On his motion, seconded by Wilson it was read a first time.
