

Trouters Falls Jan 11 1932

The Inaugural meeting of the Ross Council was held according to statute on the above date with Councilors elect all present, namely A. Wallace Beve and Councilors Wilson, Jeffrey, Currie and Ireton. After the members had taken their declaration of office they took their seat at the Council board. The minutes of the December meeting were read approved and duly signed. Bills, accounts and communications were presented Council then adjourned for one hour. On reassembling Mr Ireton gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw to authorize and provide for the payment of salaries, bills and accounts and all other necessary expenditures of its municipality for its year 1932.

Mr Jeffrey gave notice that he would at this meeting of Council introduce a bylaw to provide for the appointment of township officers for the current year.

Mr Ireton then introduced bylaw #473 of which he had given notice and on motion ^{seconded} by Mr Wilson it was read a first time.

Mr Jeffrey then introduced bylaw #474 of which he had given notice and on his motion seconded by Mr Currie it was read a first time. On motion of Ireton seconded by Wilson bylaw #473 was then read a second and third times and finally passed.

On motion of Wilson seconded by Jeffrey the bylaws in bylaw no #474 were filled in as follows.

Auditors

Treasurers Duncan McEwen Salary \$ 65.00

Assessor Dan McDonald Salary 80.00

Fence viewers - same as last year.

Pound keepers - same as last year with the exception of Arump Dunbar appointed in place of J B Dunbar.

Park Masters - same as last year with two

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exceptions namely Walter Peever in place of Tom
 Poffins and Mr Howard in place of Mr Kales.
 Sheep valuator - Samuel Gurdock, Ed Hill and Frank Croyer.
 Sanitary Inspector - Thomas Eady Sr.
 Committee to look after quarantine patients - Tom Eady Sr.
 Frank Croyer and Archie Collins.

Board of Health - Albert Wallace, Duncan Procyer, Wm John
 Cates, and Dr D A Grackler M.D.

And the bylaw was then read a second and third
 time short and finally passed.
