Also to write Jas. Rankin, Weed Inspector, to the effect that he collect the expenses of cutting weeds on Lot North-half of 13 on Con. 8 and on Village Lots 78, 79, 89 on Con. 8 from the owners or occupants.

Councillor Curry was appointed to examine bridge on Govt. Road below Mr. Wm. Bennetts before any repairing was done.
